

**RESOLUTION NO. 18-05**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO, RENEWING AND APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, COLORADO, REGARDING PUBLIC SAFETY AND ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, Part 2 of Article 1 of Title 29 of the Colorado Revised Statutes, as amended, authorizes and enables governmental entities within the State of Colorado to enter into cooperative agreements or contracts with one another to provide such functions, services or facilities lawfully authorized to each of them; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Castle Pines (the "City") previously entered into an intergovernmental agreement ("Agreement") with the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Colorado, (the "County") on behalf of the Douglas County Sheriff ("Sheriff") to provide law enforcement and animal control services by the Douglas County Sheriff within the boundaries of the City for 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the City, County and Sheriff wish to renew the Agreement, in substantially the same form as attached hereto as Exhibit A, to continue to provide law enforcement and animal control services within the boundaries of the City for 2018.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO, THAT:**

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Castle Pines, Colorado, and the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Colorado, on behalf of Douglas County Sheriff's Office, in substantially the same form as attached hereto as Exhibit A, and hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Agreement.


Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon its approval by the City Council.
