

RESOLUTION NO. 18-26

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO
SETTING THE TITLE FOR THE HOME RULE BALLOT QUESTION TO BE
SUBMITTED TO THE REGISTERED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES
IN THE NOVEMBER 6, 2018 COORDINATED ELECTION**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Castle Pines (“City”) adopted Ordinance No. 18-06 to initiate the process to establish a home rule charter commission; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 18-06 authorizes the City to participate in a coordinated election with the Douglas County Clerk and Recorder’s Office; and

WHEREAS, the process for adopting a home rule charter requires an initial election to form a charter commission and to elect members thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City has received nominating petitions from qualified electors of the City to serve on the home rule charter commission; and

WHEREAS, with the City Clerk’s receipt of such nominating petitions, the City Council desires to set the ballot title and certify the ballot order and content to the Douglas County Clerk and Recorder on or before the September 7, 2018.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO, THAT:**

Section 1. The City Council hereby refers and approves the following ballot questions for submission to the voters and to appear on the ballot for the election to be held on November 6, 2018:

Question ____: Shall the City of Castle Pines form a home rule charter commission?

Question ____: If the formation of the home rule charter commission is approved by question ___ above, then vote for no more than thirteen of the following candidates for home rule charter commission:

Section 2. The City Clerk is authorized to correct typographical errors and omissions and to cause to be entered into the blanks of the ballot questions the names of qualified candidates for home rule charter commission and the appropriate ballot question number or letter upon designation of the ballot number or letter by the appropriate election official.

Section 3. The City Manager, City Attorney, and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary and appropriate action to effectuate the provisions of this Resolution including all reasonable and necessary action to cause such approved ballot question and names of home rule charter commission candidates to be printed and placed on the ballot for the election.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining issues of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon its approval by the City Council.
