WHEREAS, the Council's heart goes out to the innocent victims who lost their lives in this tragic and baseless attack and to the families that must now deal with this act of senseless violence.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO:

The City Council hereby adopts Resolution 21-18, a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Castle Pines, Colorado, in support of the city of Boulder, Colorado's law enforcement community, the employees of King Soopers, and the victims and families of Monday's tragic shooting.
