ORDINANCE NO. 13-06

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE CONVEYANCE OF CITY-OWNED PROPERTY KNOWN AS LOT 7, CHARTER OAKS 4TH AMENDMENT, LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES TO THE DOUGLAS COUNTY LIBRARIES

WHEREAS, the City of Castle Pines (the "City") is the current record owner of the real property more particularly described in <u>Exhibit 1</u>, a copy of which is attached to this Ordinance and is incorporated herein by reference (the "Subject Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Subject Property consists of approximately 0.68 acres, more or less; and

WHEREAS, the City acquired the Subject Property for the sole purpose of conveying the Subject Property to the Douglas County Libraries, a library district formed in Douglas County pursuant to the provisions of C.R.S. §§ 24-90-101 through 119 (the "Library"), to facilitate the development of a new library on the Subject Property to benefit the citizens and taxpayers of both the City and Library District; and

WHEREAS, the Subject Property has not been used nor is intended for any governmental use by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Library have or will enter into an intergovernmental agreement (the "Library IGA"), which sets forth the terms and conditions under which the City agrees to convey the Subject Property to the Library; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized to sell and convey the Subject Property to the Library pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-15-713(1)(b); and

WHEREAS, the City Council declares the conveyance of real property as provided by this Ordinance is an exercise of its administrative power as provided by Colorado law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO:

- <u>Section 1.</u> <u>Recitals Incorporated.</u> The recitals contained above are incorporated herein by reference and are adopted as findings and determinations of the City Council.
- Section 2. Conveyance of Subject Property. The City Council hereby approves the conveyance of the Subject Property to the Library via special warranty deed ("Deed"), in accordance with the terms of the Library IGA.
- Section 3. Execution and Delivery of Deed to Escrow. The Mayor, Mayor Pro-Tem, and Deputy City Clerk are authorized to execute all documents necessary to facilitate or complete the conveyance of the Subject Property, including but not limited to the Deed, following the review and approval of all such documents as to form by the City Attorney. Following execution of the Deed conveying the Subject Property to the Library, the Deed shall be held in escrow until such time as the conditions pertaining to the conveyance of the Subject Property to the Library have been fully satisfied, as set forth in the Library IGA.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Severability.</u> If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, the intent being that the same are severable.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after publication following final adoption.
