

ORDINANCE NO. 12-02

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CASTLE PINES, COLORADO REPEALING SECTION 21(D) AND SECTION 21(E) OF
ORDINANCE NO. 11-10, RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT AND ONGOING
OPERATIONS OF SPECIAL DISTRICTS WITHIN THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES**

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 11-10, the City Council of the City of Castle Pines adopted regulations relating to the establishment and ongoing operations of special districts within the City (the "Ordinance 11-10"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend Ordinance 11-10; and

WHEREAS, specifically, the City Council desires to repeal Section 21(d) and Section 21(e) of Ordinance 11-10 and to that end has caused two (2) public hearings regarding the proposed repeal of these sections of Ordinance 11-10 to be scheduled for March 13, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. and March 13, 2012 at 8:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirements of Section 21(e) of Ordinance 11-10, notice of the public hearings to consider the repeal of Section 21(d) and Section 21(e) of Ordinance 11-10 was published in *The Douglas County News-Press* on the following dates: January 12, January 19, January 26, February 2 and February 9, of calendar year 2012; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the publisher's affidavit is on file in the office of the City Clerk;
and

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearings was also posted for a period of sixty (60) days prior to the March 13, 2012 public hearings at the City's designated posting locations and at each signalized traffic intersection in the City; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the certificate of posting is on file in the office of the City Clerk;
and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that passage of this Ordinance will promote and preserve the health, safety, and welfare of the Castle Pines community.

**THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CASTLE PINES, COLORADO:**

Section 1. Repeal. Section 21(d) and Section 21(e) of Ordinance No. 11-10 are hereby repealed in their entirety. All remaining provisions of Ordinance No. 11-10 not specifically repealed by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 2. Severability. If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be void or ineffective, it shall be deemed severed from this Ordinance and the remaining provisions shall remain valid and in full force and effect.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after publication following final adoption.






