**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF CASTLE PINES NORTH
SUPPORTING THE GRANT APPLICATION FOR A LOCAL PARKS
AND OUTDOOR RECREATION SPECIAL OPPORTUNITY GRANT
FROM THE STATE BOARD OF THE GREAT OUTDOORS COLORADO
FOR LAGAE PARK**

WHEREAS, the site of Lagae Park is within the City of Castle Pines North (“City”) and currently owned by the City; and

WHEREAS, the Castle Pines Parks Authority (“Parks Authority”) is seeking a grant in the amount of \$700,000 from the Great Outdoors Colorado Trust Fund (“GOCO”) to assist in the construction of Lagae Park; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to cooperate in and support such grant application submitted by the Parks Authority to GOCO for improvements to Lagae Park; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 29-1-204, C.R.S., as amended, governments may cooperate or contract with one another to provide any function or service lawfully authorized to each.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES NORTH, COLORADO:

Section 1. The City Council supports the application by the Castle Pines North Park Authority, who has appropriated matching funds, for a grant in the amount of \$700,000 from GOCO.

Section 2. The City’s support of the Parks Authority’s grant application does not obligate the City to match any grant funding or to otherwise contribute financially to the Lagae Park site improvements.

Section 3. The project site is owned by the City of Castle Pines North and will be owned by the City for the next 25 years.

Section 4. The Castle Pines North Metropolitan District has committed to maintaining Lagae Park in a high quality condition and will appropriate funds for maintenance in its annual budget.

Section 5. The City Council finds that the Castle Pines Parks Authority has the ability to complete this project and has demonstrated this ability in the completion of Coyote Ridge Park in 2001 and Coyote Ridge Skate Park in 2006.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon its approval by the City Council.


