**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES NORTH, COLORADO  
SUPPORTING A “YES” VOTE ON BALLOT QUESTION 2C TO CHANGE THE  
CITY’S NAME FROM THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES NORTH TO THE CITY OF  
CASTLE PINES**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Castle Pines North (“City”) is a legislative body and is vested with authority to adopt resolutions in support or opposition to local, state and federal legislation; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 10-68, the City Council of the City of Castle Pines North (“City Council”) approved various ballot questions to be presented to the registered electors of the City at the November 2, 2010 general election; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has elected to submit to a vote of the registered electors of the City a question seeking voter approval to change the name of the City from The City of Castle Pines North to The City of Castle Pines; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with § 31-11-111(2), C.R.S., the City has received confirmation from the Secretary of State’s Office as well as from the Department of Local Affairs that no other municipality in the State of Colorado is currently named The City of Castle Pines; and

WHEREAS, the City Council supports the name change from The City of Castle Pines North to The City of Castle Pines as the descriptive word “North” is not necessary to distinguish the City from other Colorado municipalities or from adjacent unincorporated communities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that changing the City’s name to The City of Castle Pines is a benefit in terms of ease of reference and simplicity; and

WHEREAS, members of City Council have received requests from residents to support the City’s name change to The City of Castle Pines; and

WHEREAS, as the incorporated boundaries of the City change, the City’s name should reflect the broader geographic area inclusive of areas such as The Canyons’ property which is located east of the existing City boundaries.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES NORTH, COLORADO, THAT:**

**Section 1.** The City Council supports a “yes” vote on Question 2C and urges the citizens to vote in favor of changing the name of the City from The City of Castle Pines North to The City of Castle Pines.


**Section 2.** If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution, the intent being that the same are severable.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect upon its approval by City Council.
