**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO  
RATIFYING THE APPOINTMENT OF AN ALTERNATE MEMBER TO THE  
COMBINED PLANNING COMMISSION/BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT AND  
CORRECTING THE TERM OF MEMBERSHIP OF DAVID C. NECKER**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 10-07 establishing a citizen-appointed Planning Commission and Board of Adjustment (collectively, the “Board”); and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has advertised for citizen volunteers to serve on the combined Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council considered the application of and appointed a citizen volunteer to serve as an alternate member on the combined Board, and hereby wishes to ratify said appointment; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council further desires to correct the term of appointment for Mr. David C. Necker to be consistent with Ordinance No. 10-07.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO, THAT:**

**Section 1.** The City Council hereby ratifies and appoints the following citizen representative to serve as an alternate member of the combined Planning Commission/Board of Adjustment:

Appointment February 9, 2011; Term to expire February 9, 2013.

**Section 2.** The term of appointment for such citizen representative shall be as stated in Section 1.

**Section 3.** The term of appointment for David C. Necker, as previously set forth in Resolution No. 10-87, is corrected to be from November 9, 2010 to November 9, 2013, which is a three year term consistent with Ordinance No. 10-07.

**Section 4.** This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
