

RESOLUTION NO. 11-82

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, CLORADO,
CERTIFYING THE MILL LEVY**

WHEREAS, the City Staff duties include the preparation and presentation of a proposed budget to the City Council of the City of Castle Pines ("City"); and

WHEREAS, the City Staff submitted the proposed 2012 budget to City Council by October 15, 2011 in compliance with C.R.S. § 29-1-105; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was properly noticed and held on November 8, 2011, which was continued to November 9, 2011, in conformance with C.R.S. §§ 29-1-106 and 29-1-108;

WHEREAS, the City Council approved the 2012 Budget by Resolution No. 11-73 and made necessary appropriations; and

WHEREAS, the 2011 net valuation for assessment of real property within the City, as certified by the Douglas County Assessor, is \$139,166,640;

WHEREAS, in accordance with C.R.S. § 39-5-128, the City is required to certify the mill levy on or before December 15, 2011, after the budget has been adopted.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Castle Pines, Colorado as follows:

Section 1. For the purpose of meeting the law enforcement expenses of the City of Castle Pines during the 2012 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 4.5 mills upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the City, which mill levy is the same as levied by the City in 2010 (for the 2011 budget year).

Section 2. The City Manager of the City is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Douglas County, Colorado, the mill levy for the City as hereinabove determined and set.


Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon it's approval by the City Council.


