

**RESOLUTION NO. 12-10**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES,  
COLORADO WITHDRAWING THE APPLICATION FOR DISSOLUTION FILED  
WITH THE CASTLE PINES NORTH METROPOLITAN DISTRICT AND REPEALING  
RESOLUTION NOS. 09-101 AND 10-08**

**WHEREAS**, on February 5, 2010, the City of Castle Pines, then known as the City of Castle Pines North (the "City") initiated statutory dissolution proceedings by filing an Application for Dissolution with the Castle Pines North Metropolitan District (the "District"); and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council believes that the interests of the citizens of the City are better served by good communication and voluntary cooperation between the City and the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the public hearings required by Section 21(d) of Ordinance No.11-10 have been scheduled and completed, following proper and sufficient public notice being given by the City.


**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO, THAT:**

**Section 1.** The City Council hereby withdraws the City's application for dissolution previously filed with the Board of Directors of the Castle Pines North Metropolitan District and directs the City Attorney to take all necessary and appropriate steps to effectuate withdrawal of the dissolution petition that was filed in Case No. 1984CV126, including joining with the Castle Pines North Metropolitan District in a stipulated motion to dismiss the dissolution proceeding with each party paying its own attorneys fees and costs.

**Section 2.** Resolution No. 09-101 and Resolution No. 10-08, both of which authorized the City to file an application for dissolution with the Castle Pines North Metropolitan District Board of Directors, are hereby repealed.

**Section 3.** This Resolution shall take effect upon its approval by the City Council.


