

**RESOLUTION NO. 12-46**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO  
CONCERNING THE ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE OF THE CITY**

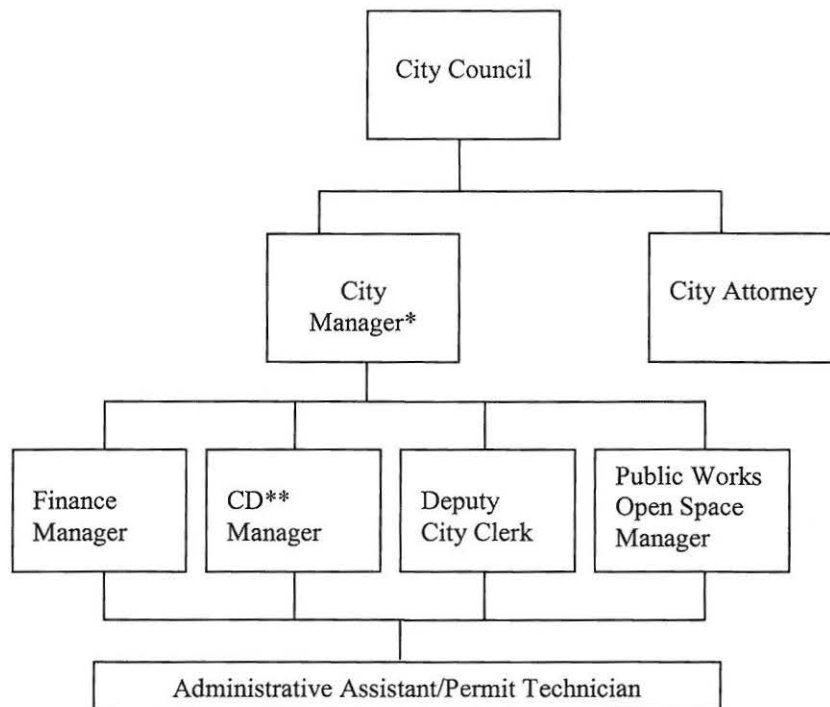
**WHEREAS**, Section 31-4-101(1), C.R.S., vests the corporate and municipal authority of the City of Castle Pines (“City”) in the City Council as the governing body of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 31-4-101(2), C.R.S., the City Council possesses all the legislative powers and all other corporate powers not conferred by law or ordinance on some other officer or agency of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to formally adopt the organizational structure of the City and to authorize the Mayor to effectuate the same.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO THAT:**

**Section 1.** The City Council formally adopts the following organizational structure to be effective on October 15, 2012 as may be amended by City Council:



\*In the absence of an appointed, full-time City Manager, City Council assumes the City Manager functions.


\*\*CD=Community Development

**Section 2.** Any and all references to "Finance Director" in the City's ordinances, rules, regulations, policies and other documents shall hereafter mean the City's designated finance manager or other employee, officer or contract employee designated by the City Council or City Manager.

**Section 3.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to take all steps necessary to effectuate the implementation of the City's organizational structure including but not limited to execution of any agreements or other documents appropriated through the City's approved budget.

**Section 4.** This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
