NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO, THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Council hereby appoints the following citizen representative to serve the remainder of the term of the vacant seat on Parks and Recreation Advisory Board:

Richard Taylor – for a term expiring on June 22, 2023.

Section 2. This appointment shall take effect on the effective date of Ordinance No. 21-03.
