

**ORDINANCE NO. 22-07**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO REPEALING AND  
REPLACING SECTION 2-10-30(b) OF THE CASTLE PINES MUNICIPAL  
CODE CONCERNING THE TERMS OF APPOINTMENT OF THE  
PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council ("Council") of the City of Castle Pines (the "City") is a home rule municipality of the State of Colorado, with authority to appoint commissions and committees; and

**WHEREAS**, Council has heretofore established the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board (the "Board") and conferred upon same such powers and duties as are more particularly described in Chapter 2, Article 10 of the City Municipal Code (the "Municipal Code"); and

**WHEREAS**, Council desires to revise Section 2-10-30(b) of the Municipal Code to establish a uniform commencement date of terms for Board members and impose term limits for Board members, as more particularly provided herein; and

**WHEREAS**, Council finds that this Ordinance is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council conducted a public hearing, with proper notice provided, to consider adoption of this Ordinance as required by law.

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO,  
ORDAINS:**

Section 1. Subsection (b) of Section 2-10-30 of the Municipal Code, titled "Membership; terms of appointment; removal," is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read in full as follows:

*Terms of appointment.* The term of appointment for each voting member, except the youth member, shall be two years and shall always commence on March 1 of the relevant year; except that Council may stagger such terms so that no more than three (3) members' terms end in any given year. Members may serve a maximum of three (3) consecutive two-year terms. The youth member, if one is appointed, shall serve a term of at least one year and up to two (2) years. City Council may establish by resolution a policy to guide the appointment and reappointment process.

Section 2. Severability. If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be void or ineffective, it shall be deemed severed from this Ordinance and the remaining provisions shall remain valid and in full force and effect, in accordance with Section 6.8 of the Charter.

Section 3. No Existing Violation Affected. Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred,

or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any ordinance hereby repealed or amended by this Ordinance, or any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 4. Repeal of Previous Ordinances. Any and all ordinances or codes or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent herewith are, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency, hereby repealed; provided, however, that the repeal of any such ordinance or code or part thereof shall not revive any other section or part of any ordinance or code heretofore repealed or superseded and this repeal shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any ordinance hereby repealed prior to the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 5. Codification Amendments. The codifier of the City's Municipal Code is hereby authorized to make such numerical and formatting changes as may be necessary to incorporate the provisions of this Ordinance within the Castle Pines Municipal Code.

Section 6. Safety Clause. The City Council hereby finds, determines, and declares that this Ordinance is promulgated under the general police power of the City of Castle Pines, that it is promulgated for the health, safety, and welfare of the public, and that this Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of health and safety and for the protection of public convenience and welfare. The City Council further determines that the Ordinance bears a rational relation to the proper legislative object sought to be obtained.

Section 7. Publication and Effective Date. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause publication of this Ordinance in accordance with Section 6.5 of the Charter. This Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after final publication on the City's official website and posting at the City Clerk's office pursuant to Section 1-3-40 of the Municipal Code.

Section 8. Publication and Effective Date. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause publication of this Ordinance in accordance with Section 6.5 of the Charter. This Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after final publication on the City's official website and posting at the City Clerk's office pursuant to Section 1-3-40 of the Municipal Code.
