RESOLUTION NO. 23-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO, AWARDING THE BID OF ROCK & CO. FOR PROJECT NO. 2023-PW-003, CONSTRUCTION OF THE I-25, CASTLE PINES PARKWAY, MONARCH BOULEVARD GATEWAY MONUMENTATION PROJECT, AND APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF A NOTICE OF AWARD

WHEREAS, the City of Castle Pines ("City") solicited bids in March of 2023 for Project No. 2023-PW-003, Construction of the I-25, Castle Pines Parkway, Monarch Boulevard Gateway Monumentation Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City advertised the Project for an ample amount of time in accordance with Colorado law by posting an invitation for bid ("IFB"); and

WHEREAS, the City received one (1) bid in response to the IFB within the time period that the Project was advertised; and

WHEREAS, City staff and its consultant evaluated the unit price bid received from bidder together with the specific criteria set forth in the IFB and considered references to determine the lowest responsible bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the tabulated bid sheet for the Project is on file with the City Clerk's Office; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intent of the City Council to award the bid to the lowest responsible bidder who submitted a bid in compliance with the reasonable and stated specifications contained within the IFB; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, after consideration of the bid submitted and the recommendations of City Staff, finds that ROCK & CO., a Colorado corporation (ROCK & CO."), submitted the lowest responsible bid for the Project; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City to award the bid for the Project to ROCK & CO. in the not to exceed amount of Two Million Five Hundred Eighty Thousand Two Hundred Seventeen Dollars and 50/100 Cents (\$2,580,217.50), based on the unit price(s) set forth in Rock & Company's bid and the estimated work quantities associated with the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to enter into a construction contract with Rock & Company to have ROCK & CO. perform the work described with particularity in the IFB and contract documents, which construction contract shall be substantially in the form of contract set forth and included in the IFB.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO, THAT:


Section 1. The City Council hereby: (a) awards the Project to ROCK & CO. in the not to exceed amount of Two Million Five Hundred Eighty Thousand Two Hundred Seventeen Dollars and 50/100 Cents (\$2,580,217.50); (b) approves a construction contract with Rock & Company in substantially the same form as attached to the IFB ("Construction Contract"); (c) authorizes the City Attorney, in consultation with City Staff, to make or negotiate such changes as may be needed to the Construction Contract so long as any changes do not substantially increase the obligations of the City; and (d) authorizes the City Manager to execute the Construction Contract on behalf of the City when the Construction Contract is in its final form.

<u>Section 2.</u> The City Council further authorizes and directs the City Manager or his designee to execute and send a Notice of Award to Rock & Company along with a copy of the Construction Contract in accordance with the procedures set forth in the IFB.

<u>Section 3.</u> If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, clauses, or provisions of this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon its approval by the City Council.
