ORDINANCE NO. 24-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO, AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF ARTICLE 10 OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE CASTLE PINES MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADD A NON-VOTING YOUTH MEMBER TO THE CASTLE PINES PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD

WHEREAS, the City of Castle Pines ("City") is a home rule municipality with all powers granted by Article XX of the Colorado Constitution and the City's Home Rule Charter ("City Charter"); and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized pursuant to Article IX of the City Charter to create and disband boards, commissions and committees and to appoint members to the same; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 19-09, the City Council created the City of Castle Pines Parks and Recreation Advisory Board ("PRAB") and delegated certain responsibilities thereto; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to give a voice to the youth residents of the City for decisions regarding the City's recreation and park services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend certain sections of Article 10 of Chapter 2 Castle Pines Municipal Code ("City Code") to add a non-voting youth member to PRAB to serve alongside the other seven (7) members currently appointed; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this Ordinance furthers the promotion of public health, safety and welfare.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO THAT:

- <u>Section 1.</u> <u>Recitals Incorporated.</u> The above and foregoing recitals are incorporated herein by reference and adopted as findings and determinations of the City Council for all purposes.
- Section 2-10-10 of the City Code is hereby amended as follows, with additions shown in <u>underline</u> and deletions shown in <u>strike through</u>:

Sec. 2-10-10. - Membership; terms of appointment; removal.

There is hereby created the City of Castle Pines Parks and Recreation Advisory Board composed of seven (7) eight (8) members to interpret the needs and desires of the community for recreation and park services.

Section 3. Section 2-10-30(a) of the City Code is hereby amended as follows, with additions shown in <u>underline</u> and deletions shown in <u>strike through</u>:

Sec. 2-10-30. - Membership; terms of appointment; removal.

- (a) Membership and qualifications. The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board shall consist of seven (7) eight (8) members as follows: (a) one (1) ex officio non-voting member who shall be a member of and selected by City Council; (b) one (1) ex officio non-voting member who shall be the City Manager or their designee; (c) one (1) ex officio non-voting member who is a youth between the ages of fourteen (14) and seventeen (17) years of age at the time of appointment and a resident of the City; and (de) five (5) at large members, one (1) of whom may be a youth between the ages of fourteen (14) and seventeen (17) years of age at the time of appointment. The members shall be appointed by City Council and shall be residents of the City. The at-large members shall represent a wide cross-section of the community to adequately represent the interests of all age groups and Council districts.
- <u>Section 4.</u> <u>Severability.</u> If any part or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.
- <u>Section 5.</u> <u>Codification Amendments.</u> The codifier of the City's Municipal Code is hereby authorized to make such numerical and formatting changes as may be necessary to incorporate the provisions of this Ordinance within the Castle Pines Municipal Code.
- Section 6. Safety Clause. The City Council finds and declares that this Ordinance is promulgated and adopted for the public health, safety and welfare and this Ordinance bears a rational relation to the legislative object sought to be obtained.
- Section 7. Publication and Effective Date. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause publication of this Ordinance in accordance with Section 6.5 of the Charter. This Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after final publication on the City's official website and posting at the City Clerk's office pursuant to Section 1-3-40 of the Municipal Code.
