

**CITY OF CASTLE PINES
RESOLUTION NO. 26-19**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES,
COLORADO NAMING CERTAIN TRAIL SEGMENTS IN THE CITY**

WHEREAS, the City of Castle Pines (the “City”), through its Parks and Recreation Advisory Board (“PRAB”), has identified 35 trail segments within the community that do not have trail names as illustrated in the attached Exhibit 1; and

WHEREAS, the City’s Parks and Recreation Advisory Board (“PRAB”) has been tasked with developing recommendations of trail names to help residents more easily identify trail locations, routes, and connections throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, PRAB’s recommended names aim to enhance wayfinding, reinforce community identity, and align with local geographic and neighborhood features; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to designate names of trail segments as set forth in this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO:

Section 1. The City Council approves the following names of designated trail segments as shown in Exhibit 1:

- a. Segment 6 shall be Briar Oaks Path;
- b. Segment 8 shall be Valley Ridge Way;
- c. Segment 9 shall be Crooked Prairie Loop;
- d. Segment 10 shall be Elk Ridge Run;
- e. Segment 11 shall be Mountain View;
- f. Segment 12 shall be Hidden Woods;
- g. Segment 15 shall be Twisted Oak Crossing;
- h. Segment 16 shall be Coyote Hill Climb;
- i. Segment 17 shall be Serena Trail;
- j. Segment 18 shall be Serena Spur;
- k. Segment 19 shall be Tall Grass Slope;

- l. Segment 20 shall be Happy Creek Crossing;
- m. Segment 21 shall be Retreat Fork;
- n. Segment 22 shall be Glen Ridge Tributary Path;
- o. Segment 23 shall be Gamble Oak.

Section 2. This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
