



# HAPPY CANYON INTERCHANGE PROJECT

To improve safety and increasing traffic volumes, the City of Castle Pines, in partnership with Douglas County and the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT), will reconstruct the Happy Canyon interchange. The project includes constructing a new bridge north of the current structure, replacing the existing bridge, rebuilding the I-25 on- and off-ramps, and implementing signal and intersection improvements throughout the interchange.

These upgrades will enhance traffic flow, improve connectivity and regional mobility, and provide the infrastructure needed to support continued growth in the Castle Pines community and surrounding area.

## PHASE 1

**Construct new bridge structure over I-25, north of existing bridge**

## PHASE 2

**Demolition of existing bridge and construction of southern bridge structure**

## PHASE 3

**Tie-in new ramps and bridge structures**

## Anticipated Schedule

*Start: July 2026*

*Completion: Mid-2028*

## Anticipated Impacts

*Construction anticipated to begin July 2026*

- Temporary lane shifts and narrowed lanes on I-25
- Nighttime I-25 closures for bridge girder installation
- Intermittent ramp closures during construction
- Lariat Drive access maintained throughout major phases

## Project Delivery Method

The project uses a **Construction Manager/General Contractor (CM/GC)** approach, bringing the contractor into design early to improve constructability, manage risk, control costs, and reduce public impacts during construction.
